### **Update to Village Independent Living Residents and Staff**

#### **I am so impressed ...**

... that most of our Village residents have not left the campus since March 16, 2020, the first day we were asked to “stay at home” by Governor DeSantis. That reflects the commitment of this community to be proactive in staying safe and healthy! Thank you each for your efforts toward this goal.

Here are a few changes we are making for next week. [Remember that even if the Governor announces that the State of Florida has moved into Phase 2 that senior living communities will continue to operate as we have in Phase I.]

#### Leaving Campus

Residents no longer must report their temperatures for 14 days after leaving campus. You will now be screened through standard procedures at the Checkpoint when you return to campus.

If you would like to leave campus with a friend or family member, please ask them to meet you at the Honore Street Checkpoint as we are not yet allowing visitors on campus. You will be screened at the Checkpoint when you return to campus.

#### Transportation

We are continuing to provide prescription pickup, essential grocery shopping, and transportation with no charge to essential medical appointments for residents that do not have a car or have not left campus in their own vehicle since March 16, 2020. Sunnyside appreciates and supports this continual effort to be proactive in avoiding unnecessary exposure to the virus. It is our belief that when residents are comfortable traveling off-campus in their own vehicle for any reason, they should be comfortable taking care of all their off-campus needs.

#### Exercise Room

We are opening the exercise room with restrictions in place. Please review all the procedure details in your March 14<sup>th</sup> memo from Debbie Smith, Resident Liaison, and Wellness Coordinator.

#### Hair Salon

The other item of significance is that we are ready to reopen our Hair Salon in the Community Center. Marty Headings, the manager of the Salon, and stylist, Beverly Milburn, will offer hours this coming week. The Salon needs to comply with the State of Florida restrictions, so please exercise Sunnyside patience in requesting your appointment. Marty will provide salon services on Monday and Wednesday, and Beverly will cover Tuesday and Thursday.
