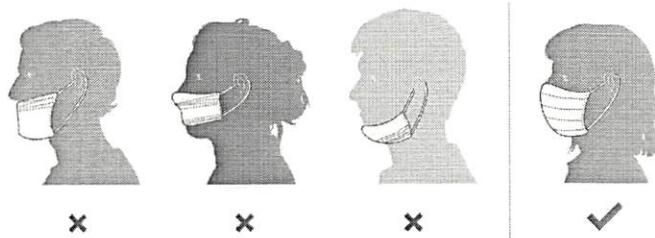

Update to Village Independent Living Residents and Staff

Important to know ...

... if you develop symptoms, stay in your home and contact your doctor as soon as possible. Inquire if your doctor is willing to send a mobile lab to come to your home for testing. Notify Debbie or J. David as quickly as possible also – they are obligated to report anyone with symptoms or a positive test to the Department of Health. If you have severe symptoms or illness, dial 0 and ask for 9-1-1 to be called.

Coronavirus update:

During our staff testing this week, all results reported are negative. The Village staff involved in last week's Covid-19 exposure have either returned to work, are improving, or did not develop symptoms. We are following the CDC guidelines regarding staff safely returning to work. Anyone who would be potentially connected with someone who is symptomatic or tests positive would be notified as soon as possible. The residents required to isolate are improving, and all others being monitored have not developed symptoms. Two additional Village residents have identified with symptoms and have both tested positive. The couple is under medical supervision. We are not aware of any staff or residents that are at risk from this exposure.

Visitation guidance:

- **Permitted on Campus** – residents, staff, medical personnel, caregivers, approved housekeepers, local friends and family members, campus service providers, trades, and federal agency personnel.
- **Visit neighbors** in your homes or outside, practicing social or physical distancing. Walk or meet up outdoors with proper physical distancing/face coverings when within 6-10 feet of others.
- **Family and friends from off campus** should go directly to your home, wear face coverings while on campus and not remain in any common areas. Physically distanced walks around the campus are acceptable.
- **Visitors from more than 25 miles away that want to visit your home** need prior approval from Debbie Smith or J. David Yoder before trying to come on campus.

Regarding common areas in the Garden Apartments:

- Face coverings are required in all common areas including, hallways, elevators, and lobbies.
- Please do not use the first-floor lobby areas to visit with family, friends, or neighbors.
- Second and third-floor common areas should not be used at this time for meetings, games, or gatherings, but are acceptable locations for small, quiet conversations if physically distanced.
- Be courteous to those neighbors who live near the common areas by keeping your noise levels moderated.

Sunnyside Village Chapel services have limited, distanced seating: Wednesday, at 10:30 a.m., Sunday at 10:30 a.m., and rebroadcast campus-wide on Sunday on both Channel 195 and 103 at 10:30 a.m.

Christian Life Class, at 10:30 a.m. in the Chapel. All safety and distancing parameters will be in effect, as the worship services.

When you order restaurant food deliveries, be sure your name and address are on the delivery packages. We have had pizza and great food delivered to 5201 Bahia Vista Street, and we never did find out who ordered it.

What is happening ...

- Sunnyside Manor Assisted Living apartments are available. Contact Amy Craig -Ext. 325
- Screening at the Checkpoint
- Show your Sunnyside name tag to Checkpoint personnel when you return to campus
- Personal housekeepers permitted if approved by Debbie Smith or J. David Yoder
- Carpet cleaning by approved service providers
- Deliveries such as groceries and food supplies from Shipt, Instacart, Grubhub, etc. can be left for you at the Checkpoint
- Packages delivered by Amazon, FedEx, and UPS are dropped off at the Checkpoint and wiped down before delivery on campus
- Lakeside Dining meal pickup/delivery
- Shopping and prescription pickup services
- Shopping on the Sunnyside bus
- Transportation to essential medical appointments at no charge if you do not own a car, have quit driving, or have not left campus since March 16 – call Ext. 266
- Bank hours are back to normal
- Village Impact window replacement
- Updated information is available on Channel 195 and the *SunnysideConnect* app
