### Update to Village Independent Living Residents and Staff

#### Flu shots ...

... are scheduled for September. Several physicians we have talked to recently have advised getting this year's flu shot, so we encourage you to speak with your doctor if you have any questions or concerns about getting the shot. Debbie Smith will distribute sign-up sheets in your mailboxes in the next weeks.

#### Important to know ...

... if you develop symptoms, stay in your home, and contact your doctor as soon as possible. Inquire if your doctor is willing to send a mobile lab to come to your home for testing. Notify Debbie or J. David as quickly as possible also – they are obligated to report anyone with symptoms or a positive test to the Department of Health. If you have severe symptoms or illness, dial 9-1-1. We follow CDC guidelines for staff or residents who develop coronavirus symptoms or test positive for the virus.

#### Coronavirus update:

We have no new positive testing or coronavirus symptoms to report today. The staff who have dealt with the virus are all back at work. Our first resident couple who contracted the virus, continues to regain strength. Our second couple is still in the hospital receiving medical treatment.

#### Visitation guidance:

- **Permitted on Campus** – residents, staff, medical personnel, caregivers, approved housekeepers, local friends and family members, campus service providers, trades, and federal agency personnel.
- **Visit neighbors** in your homes or outside, practicing social or physical distancing. Walk or meet up outdoors with proper physical distancing/face coverings when within 6-10 feet of others.
- **Family and friends from off campus** should go directly to your home, wear face coverings while on campus and not remain in any common areas. Physically distanced walks around the campus are acceptable.
- **Visitors from more than 25 miles away that want to visit your home** need prior approval from Debbie Smith or J. David Yoder before trying to come on campus.

#### Regarding common areas in the Garden Apartments:

- Face coverings are required in all common areas including, hallways, elevators, and lobbies.
- Please do not use the first-floor lobby areas to visit with family, friends, or neighbors.
- Second and third-floor common areas should not be used at this time for meetings, games, or gatherings, but are acceptable locations for small, quiet conversations if physically distanced.
- Be courteous to those neighbors who live near the common areas by keeping your noise levels moderated.

**Sunnyside Village Chapel** services have limited, distanced seating: Wednesday, at 10:30 a.m., Sunday at 10:30 a.m., and rebroadcast campus-wide on Sunday on both Channel 195 and 103 at 10:30 a.m.

Christian Life Class, at 10:30 a.m. in the Chapel. All safety and distancing parameters will be in effect, as the worship services.

**When you order restaurant food deliveries, be sure your name and address are on the delivery packages. We have had pizza and great food delivered to 5201 Bahia Vista Street, and we never did find out who ordered it.**

- Packages delivered by Amazon, FedEx, and UPS are dropped off at the Checkpoint and wiped down before delivery on campus
- Lakeside Dining meal pickup/delivery
- Shopping and prescription pickup services
- Shopping on the Sunnyside bus
- Transportation to essential medical appointments at no charge if you do not own a car, have quit driving, or have not left campus since March 16 – call Ext. 266
- Bank hours are back to normal
